## CARBON REDUCTION PLAN GUIDANCE

### Notes for Completion

Where an In-Scope Organisation has determined that the measure applies to the procurement, suppliers wishing to bid for that contract are required at the selection stage to submit a Carbon Reduction Plan which details their organisational carbon footprint and confirms their commitment to achieving Net Zero by 2050.

Carbon Reduction Plans are to be completed by the bidding supplier<sup>1</sup> and must meet the reporting requirements set out in supporting guidance, and include the supplier's current carbon footprint and its commitment to reducing emissions to achieve Net Zero emissions by 2050.

The CRP should be specific to the bidding entity, or, provided certain criteria are met, may cover the bidding entity and its parent organisation. In order to ensure the CRP remains relevant, a Carbon Reduction Plan covering the bidding entity and its parent organisation is only permissible where the detailed requirements of the CRP are met in full, as set out in the Technical Standard<sup>2</sup> and Guidance<sup>3</sup>, and all of the following criteria are met:

- The bidding entity is wholly owned by the parent;
- The commitment to achieving net zero by 2050 for UK operations is set out in the CRP for the parent and is supported and adopted by the bidding entity, demonstrated by the inclusion in the CRP of a statement that this will apply to the bidding entity;
- The environmental measures set out are stated to be able to be applied by the bidding entity when performing the relevant contract; and
- The CRP is published on the bidding entity's website.

Bidding entities must take steps to ensure they have their own CRP as soon as reasonably practicable and should note that the ability to rely on a parent organisation's Carbon Reduction Plan may only be a temporary measure under this selection criterion. The Carbon Reduction Plan should be updated regularly (at least annually) and published and clearly signposted on the supplier's UK website. It should be approved by a director (or equivalent senior leadership) within the supplier's organisation to demonstrate a clear

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured.

<b>Additional Details relating to the Baseline Emissions calculations.</b>	
Stride Treglown has held ISO 14001 Environmental Management System accreditation since 2005, gradually increasing the scope of measurement. Since 2015 we have measured and reported Scope 1, 2 & 3 emissions. Since 2022 our full Scope 1, 2 and 3 carbon emissions have been independently calculated and verified by external consultants.	
In 2024 we had our Paris agreement aligned net zero targets verified by Science Based Targets initiative (STBi) – 50% reduction in Scope 1 & 2 emissions by 2030, 90% reduction in Scope 1, 2 and 3 emissions by 2050.

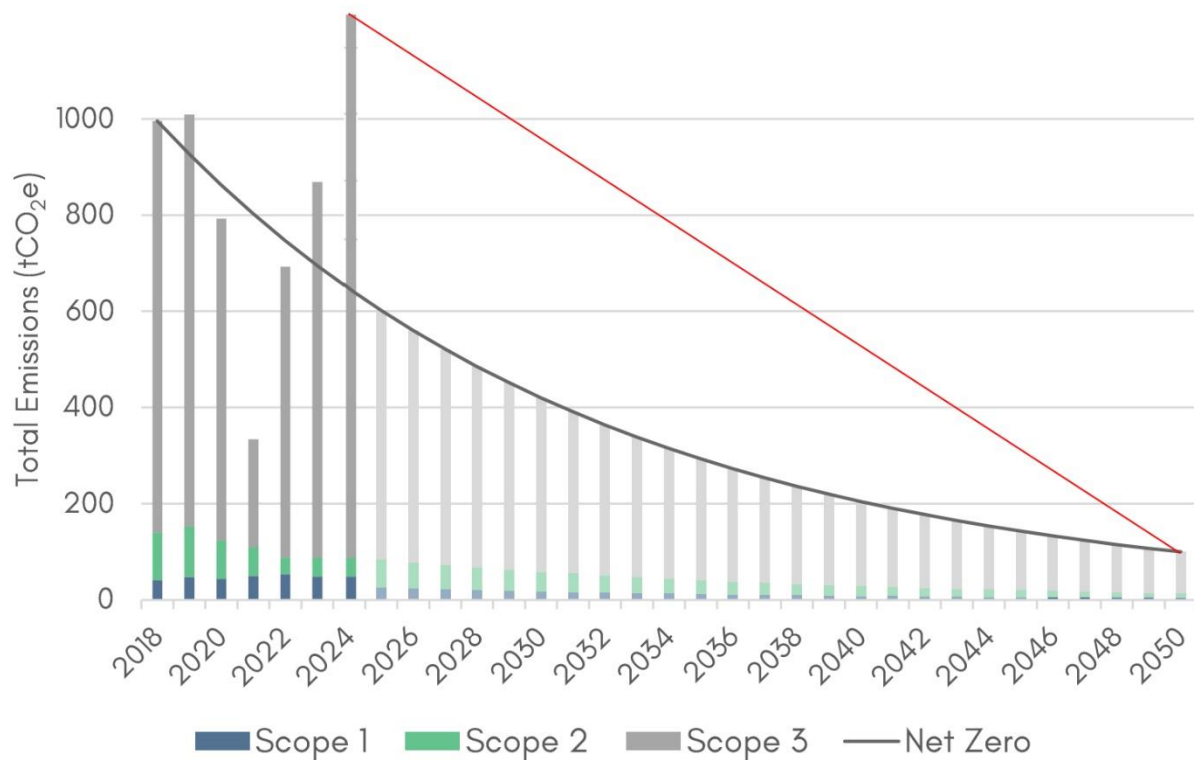
**Note:** Despite our Scope 1 & 2 emissions remaining fairly constant, because of the change in external carbon assessors, a general industry wide change in methodology for calculation Scope 3 and more accurate data collection, we have seen a significant increase in our Scope 3 emissions over the last two reported years. We anticipate that this should now remain more constant, and, rather than relying on generic sector data, we will start to obtain supplier specific carbon emissions data, which should help us to start reducing our Scope 3 emissions.

## Emissions reduction targets

In 2024 we had our Paris agreement aligned net zero targets verified by Science Based Targets initiative (STBi) – 50% reduction in Scope 1 & 2 emissions by 2030, 90% reduction in Scope 1, 2 and 3 emissions by 2050. continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that our carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to c.1,000 tCO<sub>2</sub>e by 2029. This is a reduction of 20%

## Carbon Reduction Projects

### Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since 2015. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes equate to 220.55 tCO<sub>2</sub>e, a 21% reduction against the 2015 baseline and the measures will be in effect when performing the contract.

- Energy efficiency improvements to Bristol office (Promenade House) – LED lighting, new efficient gas boiler
- Energy efficiency improvements to Bath office - LED lighting
- Energy efficiency upgrades to servers and IT equipment
- Energy efficiency improvements to Plymouth office – thermal insulation to roof and floor, PV's installed
- Switched 90% of our electricity contracts to ones providing 100% renewable electricity

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Switch our remaining electricity contracts to ones providing 100% renewable electricity
- Identify opportunities for encouraging sustainable commuting for staff
- Switch business travel from ICE cars to rail and pool EV's where possible
- Further energy efficiency upgrades to servers and IT equipment

## Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard<sup>4</sup> and uses the appropriate Government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting<sup>5</sup>.

Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions have been reported in accordance with SECR requirements, and the required subset of Scope 3 emissions have been reported in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard<sup>6</sup>.
